About Early Head Start (EHS)

EHS provides child development and family support services to low-income infants/toddlers, pregnant teens and women and their families.

The most important asset of the EHS program lies in it's purposeful design to meet the needs of families in our local community. EHS programs do this by completing a community needs assessment as required by the Head Start Program Performance Standards (HSPPS; CDR 1302.11).

In addition to center based services, EHS services are also available through partnerships formed with local childcare agencies. Child Care Partnerships (CCP) offer a viable option for families as their program needs change, as noted in our community assessment.

PSD EHS Program Options

Our program has designed and adapted services to best meet the needs of our families in the community. The PSD EHS program provides services to families using one of the following program:

- ✓ Center-Based services provide early learning, care and enrichment experiences to children in an early care and education setting. Staff members also visit family homes at least twice per year.
- ✓ Child Care Partnerships (CCP) allow for the provision of the same comprehensive EHS services via a partnering child care agency.

Benefits of CCPs:

- ✓ Extended hours of availability
- ✓ Access to the same comprehensive EHS services
- ✓ Partners receive funds to purchase new supplies, equipment, materials and facility improvements
- ✓ Child care teachers receive enhanced training, professional development, networking, and coaching via EHS



PSD Pre-K Transition

After completion of the infant/toddler program, EHS children are transitioned into the PSD Pre-K, Head Start, private Child Care center, or other age appropriate placement that families may choose. These transition procedures are designed to ensure a smooth transition into the next setting.

Recruitment & Enrollment

PSD EHS holds its Annual Recruitment Drive in March/April of each year, but applications are accepted all year long. You **must** complete an application to be considered for enrollment.
